2025 Highlights/Updates

SAVE THE DATE: Monday, February 2, 2026 for the Annual HOA meeting, at Kim Abbey's residence:

Annual Dues due:

Please pay your annual dues of \$400 as soon as possible. You can drop off a check at the house of Michael Haynes, Treasurer, at 3626 22nd Avenue SE. On his porch is a dedicated GHOA drop-box, clearly marked.

2025 Tree Update:

In 2025, the City of Olympia Urban Forestry Department approved a permit for us to remove more trees. We removed 5 trees in the spring and planted 20 trees in November. This leaves us with 33 more trees to remove and 56 more trees to plant. In 2026, we plan to remove several larger trees and plant another 15-20 trees. If you received a tree watering bag last spring from your tree planted in 2024, you can remove it for the winter, but **please put it back on in late spring** (April 2026). If you had a tree planted this November, you will receive a watering bag in the spring.

Tree Planting on your property:

Homeowners! When choosing plants/trees for your property, especially backyards, think 10 or more years ahead! Avoid plantings that will be 'too large' and would then begin to reach your roof and your neighbor's roof in the coming years.

Architectural Committee:

BEFORE you begin any new roofing or painting of your house, please submit an Architectural Application. You will find the FORM on the www.greenfieldhoa.org website. Open the 'Frequently Asked Questions' tab. and scroll to #4 'Painting and Exterior Home Modifications'. There, you may open the form. PRINT a copy to be filled and signed by TWO neighbors who approve of your color selections. Paint chips and shingle chips should be included.

The goal is to maintain the neighborhood to the highest standards applicable. Over the years, the Board has approved more varied Paint Colors for houses to modernize the community.

Attention:

Maintain your yards including the landscape strip between the street and the sidewalk adjoining your property, trees, shrubs and street drains, keeping them free of debris (Addendum to Covenants).

Keep your garbage cans out of view from the front, and placed toward the rear of your house as indicated in the Covenants (Article III, Section I).
